

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-00 2

RELATING TO ELECTIONS; CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE RIO NUEVO MULTIPURPOSE FACILITIES DISTRICT ON NOVEMBER 2, 1999

WHEREAS, by resolutions duly adopted by the Mayors and Councils of the Cities of Tucson and South Tucson (together, **the** "Cities") and the Town of Sahuarita (the "Town"), the Rio Nuevo Multipurpose Facilities District (the "District") was formed pursuant to A.R.S. §48-20I *el seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the District thereafter entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Cities and the Town, and therein authorized and employed the City of Tucson to conduct a Special Election in the District pursuant to AR.S. §48-4237 on November 2, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Special Election was held in the District on November 2, 1999 to consider Proposition 400, seeking voter approval for the receipt and use of a portion of the State transaction privilege (sales) taxes generated at the Rio Nuevo Multipurpose Facilities District site; and

WHEREAS, AR.S. §48-4237 requires approval of a majority of the voters in the City of Tucson and one other participating municipality to enable the District to use such portion of the State transaction privilege (sales) taxes for the purposes of the District; and

WHEREAS, the tabulated votes for and against Proposition 400, as submitted by the Clerk of the City of Tucson, are attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and hereby incorporated herein; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RIO NUEVO MULTIPURPOSE FACILITIES DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:




