7) **Batch Expansion Project – Possible Action**

The Board will discuss and consider ways to help Batch expand their business into the adjacent property. Based upon such discussion the Board may vote to take action, which action could include directing staff and/or counsel to draft and finalize any and all agreements necessary to implement the Board's desires and authorizing the executive officers to execute such agreements.

8) **The Kava Bar – Possible Action**

The Kava Bar on Speedway is considering a second location downtown. The Board will discuss and consider ways to launch this unique establishment downtown. Based upon such discussion the Board may vote to take action, which action could include directing staff and/or counsel to draft and finalize any and all agreements necessary to implement the Board's desires and authorizing the executive officers to execute such agreements.

9) **Sand Reckoner Winery – Possible Action**

The Board will review the status of the Sand Reckoner's opening challenges and discuss ways to accelerate the opening. Based upon such discussion the Board may vote to take action, which action could include directing staff and/or counsel to draft and finalize any and all agreements necessary to implement the Board's desires and authorizing the executive officers to execute such agreements.

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10) Pop-up Retail – Possible Action

The Pop-up Retail at the Rialto Block previously approved by the Board requires less money than allocated. The Board will discuss the reallocation of some of the funds to the Chicago Store activation. Based upon such discussion the Board may vote to take action, which action could include directing staff and/or counsel to draft and finalize any and all agreements necessary to implement the Board’s desires and authorizing the executive officers to execute such agreements.

11) Empire Pizza Expansion – Possible Action

The Board previously approved funds to assist Empire Pizza's expansion into adjacent space. That project stalled during the pandemic but the owners are ready to expand. The Board will discuss and consider the request for financial assistance for the expansion of Empire Pizza to the adjacent space. Based upon such discussion the Board may vote to take action, which action could include directing staff and/or counsel to draft and finalize any and all agreements necessary to implement the Board’s desires and authorizing the executive officers to execute such agreements.

12) TCC/Crown Castle – Possible Action

The Board will discuss the status of this project. Based upon such discussion the Board may vote to take action, which action could include directing staff and/or counsel to draft and finalize any and all agreements necessary to implement the Board’s desires and authorizing the executive officers to execute such agreements.
