To be valid, each such Request must set forth the name of the person making the request, their mailing address, the name of any group such person is representing and a brief statement of the issue they want to address.

Each public comment is limited to a maximum of three minutes. No signs or props of any kind will be allowed inside the hearing room. If a group of speakers want to present an idea, the Board asks that group to identify a spokesperson so that the Board can hear from as many interested citizens as possible.

Members of the Board may not discuss or take action on any matter raised until after the conclusion of this call to the audience and then only to (a) respond to any criticism(s) made, (b) ask the staff and/or counsel to review a matter raised or (c) place the matter on a future agenda.

6) **Future Agenda Topics – Possible Action**

Should they so decide, the Board members may discuss possible topics for future Board Meetings and based upon such discussion some or all of such matters may be included on a future agenda.
